### **Open Forum and Announcements**

**ACIS National Flag Football Update:** Andrew Fulton from UNL was named an All-American official. The Co-Rec team, D-Unit, advanced to the quarterfinals at the ACIS Championships in New Orleans. Kevin Dickens, Lee Martin and Jenna Schulz were selected as first-team All-Americans in the Co-Rec Division.

**GET REC'd CRAC booth sign-ups:** Members were asked to sign-up for one three-hour shift for the CRAC booth. GET REC'd is January 24 and 25, 11:00 AM-5:00 PM both days.

**2008-09 CRAC applications and selection:** CRAC will be handing out applications at the GET REC'd booth. Members of the selection committee will have to spend a few nights interviewing candidates and making recommendations for new members.

**Graphic Design Graduate Assistant proposal:** Campus Recreation is looking to add a graphic design artist to its staff. A description of the position was given to CRAC members. The Campus Recreation Executive Team and the entire CRec staff, along with CRAC approved the idea of allocating \$25,000 of GET REC'd revenue for the new graduate assistant position.

### **Facility Project Updates**

**Mabel Lee Fields Project:** Campus Recreation has approved the final bid documents for the project. The documents have been sent out to potential bidders with a return deadline of February 5. Construction should begin in early March and hopefully will be completed by June 1.

**Breslow Ice Center Project Update:** Bill Goa made a presentation regarding the new ice center. John Breslow has donated \$7 million towards this project. The earliest possible opening date would be August of 2009; however, it is likely to open later. A design-build process is being considered, which could speed up the construction vs. the design/bid/build process that is more common at UNL. A site has not yet been selected,

but has been reduced to a few locations in the West Haymarket area. Ice Center officials are still looking for alternative uses for one sheet of ice during the summer months.
