III. Open Forum and Announcements

A. ACIS/NIRSA National Flag Football Review- At the Tampa tournament, two of the five UNL officials that attended were selected as All American officials. At the ACIS national tournament in New Orleans and one of the four officials attended was named an All-American official. The D-Unit Team was the 2008 Nebraska Regional Co-Rec Champion and a national finalist. Our men's flag football team finished tied for 5th.

B. Referendum update- Tonight there will be a meeting at 9:30 p.m. with the Campus Wellness Ad Hoc Committee in the Nebraska Union.

C. Get Rec'd CRAC booth update- CRAC members are asked to work 2 hours. 115 of the 117 booths filled, which is significantly up over last year.

E. Search updates and open staff positions- The Coordinator of Fitness and Wellness Services position is currently being filled by Kim Barrett. The outdoor adventures position will be open until the end of the spring semester. There is an office secretary and additionally a project assistant for intramural sports position available. There will also be some graduate assistant openings in the areas of intramural sports, fitness and wellness, and external relations.
