- A. Intramural Sports Club Eligibility Rule Change – Kristen Ostdiek addressed the proposed Sport Club eligibility rule change in Article 22. The Article 22 proposal would allow multiple club players on the roster, but only allow two club players on the field/court at one time.

- B. Business Operations and Member Services –No report
- C. East Campus Recreation – Two new multi-stations have been ordered and Campus Rec is in the process of selling the two old ones. The boiler is currently running efficiently.

- D. External Relations – About 600 people attended the Nebraska vs. Missouri football game Watch Party on Thursday, Oct. 8 in the Coliseum portion of the Campus Recreation Center. There is a Campus Recreation Alumni tailgate planned for the Nebraska vs. Texas Tech game on Saturday, October 17, 2009, starting at 11:30 a.m. at the Mabel Lee Fields. There are currently 50 vendors for the 2010 GET REC'd festival. On Friday, October 23 there will be an 80 foot semi trailer outside the Coliseum portion of the Campus Recreation Center where the NCAA sports Xbox football tournament will take place.
- E. Facilities Management and Operations – No report
- F. Fitness and Wellness Services – Campus Rec is in the process of getting new weight bars because they need to be oxidized. Currently working on getting 15 elliptical machines for added cardio space in racquet ball court area. Husker Challenge has begun and ends on November 11th, 2009. On October 30, Spooks Aerobics will take place from 3:30 to 5:00 p.m.
- G. Injury Prevention and Care – The ReREV system currently has no resistance on the elliptical trainers because it shortens to the point where power isn't being generated and not strengthening the students. The Facility Operations staff are in contact with the manufacturer to correct the situation. To counter-balance the loss of income from the AP Readers Conference, IPC will be marketing to other summer conference groups. IPC's budget may be in the red this year.
- H. Facility Update – The Reunion building at 16th & W Streets will be demolished in late October/early November.

Kristen Ostdiek made and Larry Takechi seconded a motion to approve the Article 22 Intramural Sports eligibility rule regarding Sport Club membership participation and immediately implement it. The motion received unanimous approval.

Article 22: Members of Sport Clubs are eligible for Intramural Sports participation in the sport(s) in which they are Sport Club members. A maximum of two Sport Club members may be on the playing field/court at any given time. Other restrictions may be specified in the activity's flyer or rules. Protests must be lodged at the time of the infraction and violation of this rule will result in forfeiture of the match. Sport Club membership will be determined by the Assistant Director for Sport Clubs.

LaRita Lang made and Kristen Ostdiek seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion received unanimous approval. The meeting was adjourned at 5:05 p.m.
